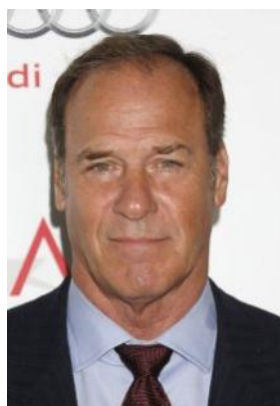

“HOT BATH AN A STIFF DRINK” FILMING SCHEDULE BEGINS AT OLD TUCSON

(TUCSON, AZ) Principal photography on a new western feature film, HOT BATH AN A STIFF DRINK, has begun at Old Tucson’s Mescal set. The current production schedule includes multiple days at Old Tucson (shooting dates at Old Tucson will be posted on our website and are subject to change). Filming is expected to go through mid-February. Guests are welcome to visit Old Tucson during the shoot. Old Tucson is open daily from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through January 30 and 10:00 am to 6:00 pm beginning February 1. Additional locations included in the film are Colossal Cave, Golder Ranch, and Tucson Mountain Park.

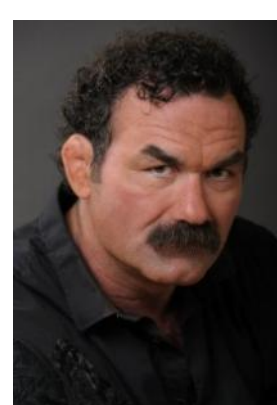
