(Tucson, AZ) Old Tucson would like to thank the Tucson community for their support of its event-packed 2012-2013 season. The Cowboy Music Festival & Western Art Show (Sat. April 27th and Sun., April 28th) closed out the park's 7-day operating schedule. In May, park hours will be 10am to 5pm on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays as well as on Monday, May 27th, Memorial Day.

From May 28th through October 3rd, Old Tucson will be open by reservation only for groups interested in guided tours and private events such as weddings, corporate functions, and company picnics as well as for scheduled film projects. In addition, we will perform needed maintenance, make facilities improvements, and prepare for Nightfall, our popular month-long Halloween event.

"Consolidating operational resources during the peak season allows us to provide an optimal guest experience by entertaining guests when our climate is more welcoming," stated Old Tucson General Manager and CEO Pete Mangelsdorf. "During the off-season, we have several private group events, weddings, and quinceañeras scheduled and will continue to book that business. Additionally, we have six film productions currently scheduled and several more have expressed interest."

Nightfall, Old Tucson's Signature Halloween-themed event returns September 27th and will be open Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays through October 31st.

On Friday, October 4th, Old Tucson will re-open to the general public on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from 10am to 4pm. During November and December, operating hours will extend to 5pm with additional operating days during Thanksgiving and Christmas weeks.
